

The following guidelines may apply to a school's dress code:

- **Coverage & Materials:** Clothing made of transparent or see-through materials, open backs, or cut-outs is prohibited.
- **Tops:** Tops must completely cover the midriff, sides, and back, and substantially cover a student's chest (e.g., no lower than the horizontal line of your underarms). Tops are required to meet a student's bottoms with no exposed midriff or belly button. Tops must cover undergarments.
- **Bottoms:** Shorts, skirts, and dresses must reach below the fingertip of naturally hanging arms and hands. Bottoms must cover undergarments.
- **Footwear:** Students must wear secure footwear, including closed-toe and closed-heel. For safety reasons, flip-flops, slides and similar type shoes are not permitted.
- **Facial Coverings:** Ski masks, hoods or other non-religious face coverings are NOT permitted for any reason (excluding medical masks). Similarly, make-up/face paint that prevent school staff members from being able to identify a student is also not permitted.
- **Prohibited Content:** Students cannot wear clothing that includes objectively offensive or discriminatory material, incites violence and/or encouragement of drug/alcohol use, or clothing that is otherwise likely to cause disruption.
